Scenario Assumption Refinements

- Scenario assumption refinements in March are focused on:
 - Local Projects
 - Groundwater
 - Demands
- Engaging with Metropolitan's Board, Member Agencies, Groundwater Managers and Demand Experts
- Feedback received will be incorporated to produce the refined gap analysis
- Member Agency review of refined gap analysis will begin in April

Local Projects Assumption Refinements

- Discussed underlying drivers and impacts to local project implementation at the IRP Technical Workgroup #8 on February 22nd
- Requested project inventories for each scenario - due today March 12th
- Metropolitan staff will incorporate member agency information into projected local supply development for the scenarios

Groundwater Assumption Refinements

- Groundwater is the largest local supply source that meets about a third of total regional consumptive demand
- Scheduling separate workshops by basin with associated member agencies and basin managers this month
 - OC Basins (March 11)
 - Central & West Coast Basins (March 12)
 - Main San Gabriel Basin (March 18)
 - Chino Basin (March 24)
 - Upper Los Angeles River Area Basins (TBD)
- Seeking input to refine preliminary groundwater scenario assumptions
