For government agencies, please attach a copy of the appointed representative's business card for that agency, as well as completed and signed IRS Form W-9. For an heir of a deceased payee, please provide proof supporting your claim of heirship as the additional documentation. Claims shall be filed before the end of May 16, 2025. Pursuant to Government Code section 50050, et seq., all funds not claimed by May 16, 2025 will become the property of Metropolitan. Metropolitan previously published a notice of unclaimed funds on April 1, 2025. Therefore, this notice constitutes Metropolitan's second and final notice.
