JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: MAINTENANCE MECHANIC I

DEPARTMENT: Engineering and Management

BRIEF: A journeyman maintenance position involving work

of a general maintenance nature or work in a specific craft as a carpenter, welder, painter, construction equipment operator, machinist, plumber, auto mechanic, or special equipment mechanic. Performs under minimum direction.

FUNCTIONS:

1. Responsible for all operational functions and maintenance of equipment when assigned to a major control facility.

- Practices a craft at journeyman level.
- 3. May direct and train other craft helpers and trainees.
- 4. Performs general and preventative maintenance work.
- Performs general construction.
- Is required to furnish basic hand tools, measuring devices, etc., as related to and commonly used in the trade.
- 7. Positions assigned to a District Water Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, may be called upon to assess and respond to chemical releases and spills.
- Positions assigned to a District Filtration Plant or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall observe operational and safety regulations pertaining to Metropolitan's Chemical Responder Program.
- 9. Performs other related work as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Four years directly related, full-time general maintenance or specified skill(s) experience. A valid California driver's license Class III or higher, is required. A Grade II California Water Treatment Operator Certificate (as issued by the State of California) may be required.

PHYSICAL CLASS:

4-heavy; Positions assigned to a District Water Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall receive training in the use of appropriate safety equipment, including a Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), and shall be required to maintain the ability to wear a SCBA.
