TITLE: MAINTENANCE WORKER II

DEPARTMENT: Engineering and Management

BRIEF: A semi-skilled maintenance position involving

work at a general maintenance nature or work in such a particular craft(s) as carpentry, welding,

electrical, painting, construction equipment

operation, machinery, plumbing and auto

mechanics.

FUNCTIONS:

May patrol main aqueduct or distribution system to inspect facilities, take readings, and operate system appurtenances.

- Performs duties associated with a reservoir, aqueduct, control or filtration facility.
- Performs general and preventative maintenance work.
- 4. Normally assists on assignments requiring two or more personnel.
- 5. Performs mechanical functions including clean-up of work areas.
- 6. May occasionally direct activities of a small work group.
- Positions assigned to a District Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall observe operational and safety regulations pertaining to Metropolitan's Chemical Responder Program.
- 8. Performs other related work as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Two years directly related, full-time general maintenance or specified craft(s) experience. A valid California driver's license Class III or higher will be required. A Grade II California Water Treatment Operator Certificate (as issued by the State of California) may be required.

PHYSICAL CLASS:

4-heavy; Positions assigned to a District Water Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall receive training in the use of appropriate safety equipment, including a Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), and shall be required to maintain the ability to wear a SCBA.
