

JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: MAINTENANCE WORKER III

DEPARTMENT: General Manager

BRIEF: A skilled maintenance position involving work of a general maintenance nature or work in such a particular craft(s) as carpentry, welding, electrical, painting, construction equipment operation, machinery, plumbing and auto mechanics.

FUNCTIONS:

1. Assists on projects requiring two or more personnel.
2. Assists in training other maintenance personnel.
3. Performs general and preventative maintenance work.
4. May be required to work rotating shifts.
5. Positions assigned to a District Water Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, may be called upon to assess and respond to chemical releases and spills.
6. Positions assigned to a District Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall observe operational and safety regulations pertaining to Metropolitan's Chemical Responder Program.
7. Performs other related work as required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Three years directly related, full-time general maintenance or specified craft(s) experience.
2. A valid California driver's license Class C or higher is required.
3. A Grade II California Water Treatment Operator Certificate (as issued by the State of California) may be required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

May be required to furnish basic hand tools, measuring devices, etc., as related to and commonly used in the trade.

PHYSICAL CLASS:

4-heavy; Positions assigned to a District Water Filtration Plant, or Chemical Unloading Facility, shall receive training in the use of appropriate safety equipment, including a Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), and shall be required to maintain the ability to wear a SCBA.
